#### **Lesson 1: Messianic Prophecy**

- 1. Where is the first prophecy of Christ found? (Genesis 3:15)
- 2. What did God say the Son was going to do to Satan? (Crush his head)
- 3. Who was the first man God made promises to concerning the Messiah? (Abraham)
- 4. What name(s) did Isaiah say the Messiah would be called? (Wonderful; Counselor; Mighty God; Everlasting Father; Prince of Peace)
- 5. What did Jesus want the people around Him to understand? (That He was the Messiah)
- 6. For what did Isaiah predict that the Messiah would suffer? (The sins of the world)
- 7. Isaiah explained that Jesus would be beaten, \_\_\_\_\_, and smitten for our sins. (Bruised)
- 8. What does, *Eli, Eli, lama sabachthani* mean? (My God, My God, why have You forsaken me?)
- 9. What is a prophecy? (God informing man about His will—often in the future)
- 10. What chapter in Isaiah talks about the sufferings of Christ? (Chapter 53)

#### Lesson 2: Jesus' Birth: Announcement to Mary; Birth in Bethlehem; Escape to Egypt

- 1. What angel told Mary she would have a Son? (Gabriel)
- 2. What name did the angel say the Son would be given? (Jesus)
- 3. What does the name "Jesus" mean? (Savior)
- 4. In what city was Jesus born? (Bethlehem)
- 5. Were Joseph and Mary from that city? (No)
- 6. What was Joseph and Mary's hometown? (Nazareth)



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- 7. When Jesus was born, in what was he wrapped? (Swaddling clothes)
- 8. What are swaddling clothes? (Strips of cloth that were wrapped around a baby to keep his/her arms and legs straight)
- 9. What prophet predicted the city where Jesus would be born? (Micah)
- 10. Why were Joseph and Mary going to Bethlehem? (To pay taxes)

#### Lesson 3: Jesus' Family & Family Tree

- 1. What was the name of Jesus' mother? (Mary)
- 2. What was Mary's husband's name? (Joseph)
- 3. What tribe of Israel was Jesus from? (Judah)
- 4. What are the names of the four half-brothers of Jesus? (James, Jude or Judas, Joseph, and Simon)
- 5. How did Joseph treat Jesus? (As his own son)
- 6. In what town did Jesus spend His childhood? (Nazareth)
- 7. What are the names of the two brothers of Jesus who wrote books of the New Testament? (Jude and James)
- 8. Did Jesus have to make choices about right and wrong? (Yes)
- 9. Among Jesus and his brothers, who was the oldest? (Jesus)
- 10. What was Joseph's job? (Carpenter)

- 5. Did Jesus stay behind in Jerusalem when His family left? (Yes)
- 6. How many days did Jesus' parents search for Him? (3 days)
- 7. Where did Joseph and Mary find Jesus? (At the Temple)
- 8. What was Jesus doing at the Temple? (Talking with rabbis)
- 9. What did the rabbis think about Jesus? (They were surprised at His understanding)
- 10. What is a rabbi? (Jewish teacher of the Law)

#### Lesson 5: John the Baptizer: Birth to Early Ministry

- 1. Who was John the Baptizer's father? (Zacharias)
- 2. What was Zacharias's role? (Priest)

- 3. Where was Zacharias when Gabriel appeared to him? (Temple)
- 4. What did Gabriel tell Zacharias? (That he would have a son)
- 5. What did Gabriel tell Zacharias his son would do? (Prepare the people for the coming Messiah)
- 6. What was Zacharias to call his son? (John)
- 7. What did Zacharias ask for to see if what the angel was telling him was true? (A sign)
- 8. What did God do to Zacharias as a result? (Made him mute)
- 9. How long would Zacharias be unable to talk? (until after his son was born)

#### Lesson 6: Jesus' Baptism & Temptations

- 1. Who was one of the last prophets of the Old Testament? (John the Baptizer)
- 2. What does "prophet" mean? (inspired preacher)
- 3. How old was Jesus when the Father was ready for Him to start His ministry? (30 years old)
- 4. Where did Jesus go when He was preparing to start His ministry? (Jordan River)
- 5. What special messenger was waiting for Jesus by the Jordan River? (John the Baptizer)
- 6. When Jesus came to John, what did Jesus want? (For John to baptize Him)
- 7. Why did John not want to baptize Jesus? (Because he knew that Jesus was the son of God, and He had done nothing for which he needed to repent)
- 8. How did John feel when Jesus came to him to be baptized? (John felt that he should be baptized by Jesus)
- 9. Who from the Godhead was present at Jesus' baptism? (God the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit)
- 10. How was the Godhead manifested? (The Father spoke from Heaven; The Spirit appeared in the form of a dove, and the Son was Jesus)
- 11. How long did Jesus go without eating after His baptism? (40 days)
- 12. How many times did Satan tempt Jesus? (three)
- 13. What was the first thing Satan tried to tempt Jesus with? (Food)

#### Lesson 7: Jesus Chooses Twelve Apostles

- 1. How many apostles did Jesus choose? (12)
- 2. What is a disciple? (A person who wants to be a follower of a certain teacher)
- 3. What is an apostle? (A specially chosen preacher. Literally, "one sent forth")
- 4. What did Jesus do the night before He started choosing His apostles? (Prayed)
- 5. Were the apostles perfect men? (No, they were regular humans)
- 6. Which apostle denied Jesus three times? (Peter)
- 7. Which apostle betrayed Jesus? (Judas Iscariot)

- 8. What were the names of the apostles who were brothers? (James and John; Peter and Andrew)
- 9. What was the apostle's name who was a twin? (Thomas)
- 10. Which three apostles slept in the garden while Jesus was praying? (Peter, James, and John)

#### **Lesson 8: Beatitudes**

- 1. What is the reward for those who are poor in spirit? (The kingdom of Heaven)
- 2. What is the reward for those who mourn? (Will be comforted)
- 3. What is the reward for those who are meek? (Will inherit the Earth)

- 7. Did people watch Jesus perform miracles and still not do what He said to do? (Yes)
- 8. Why did the wise man dig deep? (To find a good foundation to build on)
- 9. Is hearing the Word of God and not doing it something a wise man would do? (No)
- 10. Will Jesus have mercy on a person who hears His words, but does not do them? (No)
- 11. Is God's Word as solid as a rock, spiritually speaking? (Yes)
