Eight days later, Jesus appeared again so that Thomas could see Him for Himself. Jesus said to him, "Thomas, because you have **seen** Me, you have **believed**. Blessed are those who have **not seen** and yet have **believed**" (John 20:29). Thomas had a faith problem. Hebrews 11:6 tells us that "without **faith** it is **impossible** to please God."

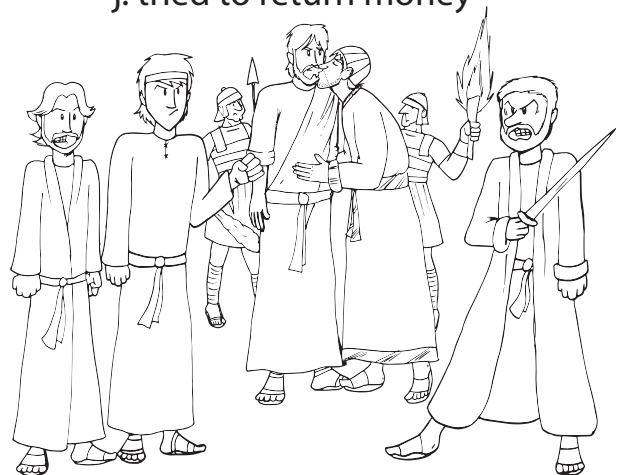

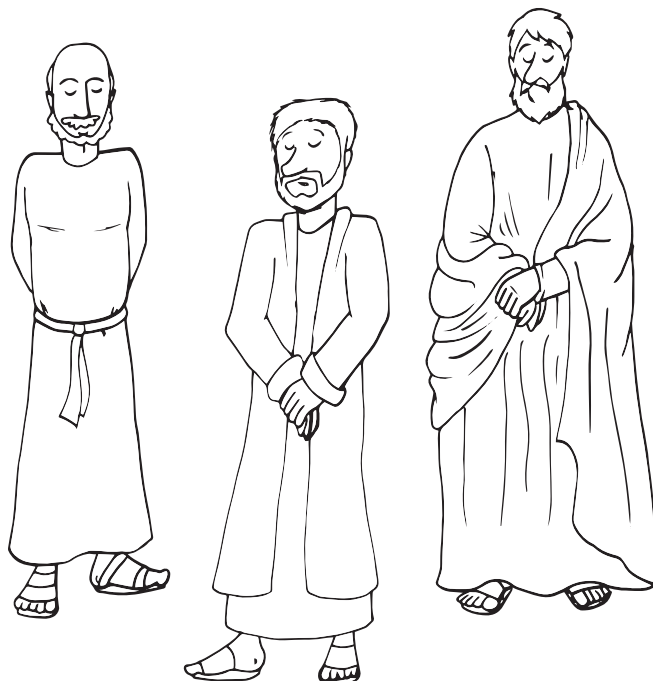
