What About Thomas Code Activity

Jesus planned to go to Bethany in Juda because Lazarus was dying. Most of the disciples were afraid, But Thomas said, "Letus go with Him that we may die with Him" (John 11:16) After Jesus' resurrection, He appeared to the apostles, but Thomas was not there. When the eleven apostles told him they had seen Jesus, he said, "Unless I see in His hands the print of the nails, and put my hand into His side, I will not believe" (John 20:25). Eight days later, Jesus appeared again so that Thomas could see Him for Himself. Jesus said to him, "Thomas, because you have seen Me, you have believed. Blessed are those who have not seen and yet have believed" (John 20:29). Thomas had a faith problem. Hebrews 11:6 tells us that "without faith it is impossible to please God."


