

Hannah Prays for a Son Coloring Sheet



Now the sons of <u>Eli</u> were corrupt; they did not know the <u>Lord</u>. And the <u>priests</u>' custom with the people was that when any man offered a sacrifice, the priest's servant would come with a three-pronged <u>fleshhook</u> in his hand while the meat was <u>boiling</u>. Then he would thrust it into the pan, or kettle, or <u>caldron</u>, or pot; and the priest would take for himself all that the fleshhook brought up. So they did in <u>Shiloh</u> to all the <u>Israelites</u> who came there. Also, before they burned the fat, the priest's servant would come and say to the man who <u>sacrificed</u>, "Give meat for <u>roasting</u> to the priest, for he will not take <u>boiled</u> meat from you, but <u>raw</u>." 


Saul the First King Coloring Sheet
