


#### **Donkey Cutouts**






#### **Jesus Cutouts**

## **Sequencing Activity**

Mary anointed Jesus' feet and head at the special supper prepared for Him at the home of Lazarus.
Jesus ate the Passover meal with His apostles and washed their feet.
Jesus walked with eleven of His apostles toward the Garden of Gethsemane to pray.
Judas brought a large crowd to the Garden. Judas kissed Jesus' cheek to show the soldiers Who they should arrest.
Peter cut off the ear of Malchus. Then Jesus performed His last miracle before His death by putting the man's ear back on.
Jesus and Simon were forced to carry the cross to the Hill of Golgotha.
The soldiers put a spear through Jesus' side to make sure that He was dead.
Joseph and Nicodemus, who were granted permission by Pilate, took Jesus' body, prepared it for a proper burial, and brought it to the tomb.




## **Sequencing Activity**

The tomb was guarded by soldiers and sealed with wax.
An earthquake came, and an angel rolled the stone away from the tomb. Mary and the other women entered the tomb and found two angels there.
The women went and told the apostles that Jesus had risen, like they were instructed to by the angels.
After Jesus' resurrection, He gave the apostles a set of instructions called the Great Commission.
Forty days after His resurrection, the apostles watched as Jesus went up into the clouds.
