He was <u>twenty-five</u> years old when he became king, and he reigned <u>twenty-nine</u> years in Jerusalem. His mother's name was <u>Abi</u> the daughter of <u>Zechariah</u>. And he did what was <u>right</u> in the sight of the Lord, according to all that his father <u>David</u> had done.

He removed the high places and broke the sacred pillars, cut down the wooden image and broke in pieces the bronze serpent that <u>Moses</u> had made; for until those days the children of Israel burned incense to it, and called it <u>Nehushtan</u>. He trusted in the Lord God of Israel, so that after him was none like him among all the kings of <u>Judah</u>, nor who were before him. For he held fast to the Lord; he did not depart from following Him, but kept His <u>commandments</u>, which the Lord had commanded Moses. The Lord was with him; he <u>prospered</u> wherever he went. And he <u>rebelled</u> against the king of <u>Assyria</u> and did not <u>serve</u> him.






